"How do I get my photos from the mobile to the laptop now?" I didn't know that I could also add a YouTube link".

The testers of an app-based SEE U walk through the district Hietzing in Vienna had these and similar questions and aha experiences. Using tablets and smartphones, the older people explored the Viennese district together and not only got to know their neighbourhood from new perspectives, but also tried out various digital devices and applications.

The Erasmus+ project SEE U - Senior Explorers in Urban Environments is all about this fun and playful approach to the digital world. Older people in Vienna, Prague and Ljubljana develop their own interactive walks and pass on their knowledge, e.g. about the special features of their living environment, about architecture or music. In this way, they become visible as experts. Open, flexible and inspiring learning settings that also promote learning from each other are particularly important to us. The learners participate according to their interests and possibilities. The walks are tested together with older people and are available free of charge beyond the project.
